Pelvic exam is a important part of the exam for female patients and important towards making various diagnoses such as yeast vulvovaginitis, bacterial vaginosis, lichen sclerosis, cancers such as cervical cancer, anal/rectal cancer, sexually-transmitted infections (gonorrhea, chlamydia, trichomonas, syphilis, herpes and human papillomavirus) and many other diagnoses.

Pelvic Exams and Evaluations

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION GENERAL: The patient is awake and alert, in no apparent distress, appropriate, pleasant and cooperative. No dysarthria is noted. No discomfort on presentation is noted. HEAD: Atraumatic, normocephalic. Pupils are equal, round and reactive to light. Extraocular muscles are intact. Sclerae are white without injection or icterus.

The pelvic floor, also called the pelvic diaphragm, is a bowl-shaped muscular sheet whose main functions are to support the abdominal and pelvic organs and to control the opening and closing of the urethral and anal sphincters. 3 The pelvic floor rests at the bottom of the pelvis and is formed mainly by the levator ani muscle group.

A pelvic examination is indicated for. Symptomatic patients (eg, those with pelvic pain) Asymptomatic patients with specific indications (eg, need for cervical cancer screening) Some experts recommend that patients < 21 years have pelvic examinations only when medically indicated and that patients ≥ 21 years have pelvic examinations annually.

It can also be used assess a patient's anatomy in preparation for procedures.

Pelvic Exam Indications: The pelvic exam is typically done in a number of settings: As part of cervical cancer screening, which involves a PAP smear. For an average risk woman, this is offered starting at age 21, and is repeated every 3 years if the findings are normal.
